Management standards

A: Prohibited Substances

- Prohibited substances (A) are ones which must not be contained in products, and their uses are prohibited in principle (except when there is an exemption based on laws and regulations).
- If each regulation has a threshold, follow those conditions.

B: Managed Substances

• Managed substances (B) are ones which conform to "JAMP declarable substances" given by "Joint Article Management Promotion-consortium" (JAMP)*3. Although it is not limited to contain these substances in products intentionally, whether any product contains these substances or not should be understood and reported and, if they are contained, the amount of the contained substances should also be understood and reported.
